It is customary for those who wish to have a funeral at our church to use the staff (Priests, Event Coordinator, and Musicians) that serve our church for the service. An Episcopal Priest must be present and preside over a funeral in this church. While we are happy to work with other clergy, any visiting priest must meet with the Rector or clergy of CHT before the service can be scheduled. Also, we use the Episcopal liturgy for the Burial of the Dead from the Book of Common Prayer, 1979. Holy Communion can also be served as part of the service.

Flowers are welcome to be displayed during the service.

The Priests will meet with family members to provide any kind of counseling or comfort needed. They will also go through with the family the various options in the service. There are two rites (or versions) of this liturgy, one with traditional language (think Elizabethan verse) or the other with contemporary language. We encourage family members to choose readings from the scripture or other writings that have special meaning to the family. We also encourage family and friends to participate in the service by reading, offering remarks about their loved ones, etc. The priest or other minister will give a homily during the service. And services can include Holy Communion, if so desired.
